



RUFÜS DU SOL ANNOUNCE SUPPORT ACTS FOR THEIR FALL ‘SOLACE TOUR’
LANE 8, ICARUS, CUBICOLOUR, AND CASSIAN TO JOIN THE AUSTRALIAN TRIO

Today, RUFÜS DU SOL – one of the world’s preeminent live electronic bands - have announced support acts for their 2018 fall ‘Solace Tour’. This Never Happened label head and no-phone-show pioneer **Lane 8**, UK house duo **Icarus**, Anjunadeep’s rising stars **Cubicolor**, and Australia’s **Cassian** will all join the supergroup as they embark on a 24-date tour of the US, already selling out three consecutive nights at the Shrine in Los Angeles.

Denver native **Lane 8**’s rise to stardom has been meteoric. He defied expectations on his debut album ‘*Rise*’, only to shatter them once more on his sophomore album, the sensational ‘*Little By Little*. Critical acclaim, the introduction and subsequent sell-outs of his new no-phones show concept ‘This Never Happened’ and his pitch perfect melodic house style has seen him become a household name in dance music.

Icarus have had a banner year - releasing their debut EP 'In the Dark' to much fanfare and landing their 5th Annie Mac 'Hottest Record in The World' (the current record) with their single 'Flowers'. This duo represents the next iteration of UK House and are two of the most buzzed about DJs on the scene.

Backed by the tastmaking Anjunadeep, Amsterdam's **Cubicolor** round out the bill with Sweat It Out Music's **Cassian**, a close friend of Rufus du Sol.

The SOLACE Fall Tour will touch down at seminal venues such as Los Angeles' Shrine Expo Hall (3 nights), New York's Terminal 5 (3 nights), San Francisco's Bill Graham Civic Auditorium, Denver's The Fillmore Auditorium (2 nights), House of Blues Boston (2 nights) and Houston, and more plus a massive festival play at Voodoo Music & Arts Experience in New Orleans.

This tour announcement comes on the wake of the band's unveiling of the first track, *No Place*, off the album which marks the first new music from the trio in more than two years. The track has already amassed 8-digit streaming numbers and earned a spot in Spotify's most coveted 'New Music Friday' playlist, as well as became the face of Spotify's '[Chill Tracks](#)' playlist.

Comprised of members Tyrone Lindqvist, Jon George and James Hunt, RÜFÜS DU SOL occupy the intersection of entrancing indie music and intelligent electronica. It is through this seamless transcendence of styles that their own sonic realm has unfolded; a landscape painted with the club culture of yesteryear and a poignant yet infectious ability to be ever in the moment.

The band's debut album, *ATLAS*, reached No. 1 on the Australian charts and reaped Platinum status – successes that were repeated with its follow-up record, *Bloom*. Released in 2016, *Bloom* offered such iconic singles as "You Were Right" and "Innerbloom," and launched RÜFÜS DU SOL on a two-year international tour, playing over 100 sold-out shows across 13 countries.

"The Australian trio knows how to set a mood, and sell it well," noted *Billboard* while *MTV* tipped RÜFÜS DU SOL as "poised for worldwide breakout."

RÜFÜS DU SOL has spent the past year in Venice, CA, writing and recording their third album, which is largely influenced by the stark desert landscapes of California and their experiences on the road.

"It feels like a new RÜFÜS," the trio says. "We are inspired by our new home out here, by the people we've met and the music we've heard along the way. We've got a refreshed sense of ambition and cannot wait to share our creation with the world."
